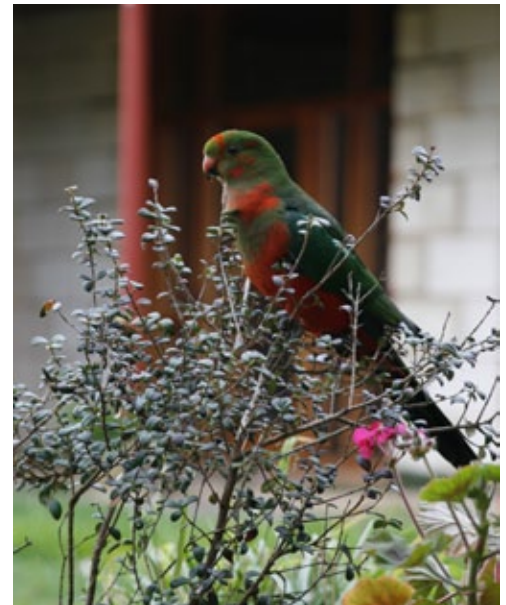

'My Special Scene' – Conditions of Entry

1. Entry is available to members of all households that regularly receive a copy of the Village Bell.
2. All entries are to be entered into either the '15 years and younger' or 'open' section and are judged first. Upper Beaconsfield Photographs, marked as such on the rear of the photo, will then be judged for the best entry.
This means an entry can win a place in a category, as well as the Upper Beaconsfield prize.
3. An Upper Beaconsfield photograph is defined as: The entry must be photographed in Upper Beaconsfield, or be of Upper Beaconsfield. If photographing a subject in Upper Beaconsfield necessitates the incidental inclusion of surrounding areas that will be acceptable.
4. Where people in photographs can be clearly identified, their permission to allow the image to be used in the competition must be obtained.
5. The owner enters their works entirely at their own risk. The Village Bell discourages any illegal or unsafe actions by an entrant to produce a photograph.
6. The judges will administer all business emerging from the interpretation and application of the competition's terms and conditions. On all matters, the judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. The winners will be notified before the 2011 Village Festival.
8. Entries can be collected during the last half hour of the Village Festival or by special arrangement.
9. The entrants will allow their images to be used for Village Bell publicity purposes.
10. Judges and their families and professional photographers are not eligible to enter.

If you want to mount your photos, then our sponsor 'ART defined' at Shop 14, Beaconsfield Plaza, will charge no more than \$6 to mount an A4 sized photograph, a little less for smaller images. To receive this service, just show your entry form.
